MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR DATA COLLECTION

SERVICE RECORD:

Referrals involve connecting individuals with appropriate services (internal and external) to meet their needs. Agencies refer clients to a wide variety of service providers that are organized within eight main categories

1) Addiction services	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• addiction services
2) Harm reduction services	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• harm reduction services
3) Clinical service providers (HIV care)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• HIV clinical care• PEP and PrEP
4) Clinical service providers (non-HIV specific)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• health care facility / hospital• health care professional (non-HIV)• Hep C testing / clinical care
5) Mental health service providers	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• community mental health agency• counselling service
6) HIV / STI testing	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• HIV testing• STI testing / sexual health clinic
7) Community-based HIV service providers	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• other AIDS service organization or HIV program
8) Other community-based service providers	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• community food bank• continuing education• day programs (seniors, brain injury)• employment support• faith-based organization• housing provider• legal aid / legal service agency• online resources• population specific services• public health• settlement agency• smoking cessation program• social services (incl. EI, OW, ODSP)
